

Important Information for all Show Participants

- Please make your check out to Ashland Farm.
- Mail all entries to: Ashland Farm, 516 Highway 81, Covington, GA 30014.
- General Fees:
 - * A \$15 Admin / EMT fee will be charged at each show, per entry for each horse/rider combination.
 - * Incomplete entries make extra work and will be charged a \$10 fee. Please submit your entries on time, with a check and these required items:
 1. All GDCTA recognized shows must include a signed **GDCTA "Hold Harmless" release**, unless we already have a signed 2007 release from you on file.
 2. Proof of **negative coggins** within 1 year of event must be submitted with each entry.
 3. The release at the bottom of entry forms must be signed. A parent or guardian must sign a release for riders under 18.
 - * Late Fee (after the closing date, one week prior to each show): \$10
 - * Returned check fee: \$20.
 - * Non-competing horse fee: \$15
- Refund policy:
 - Before closing date, check will be returned.
 - After closing date, no refund.
 - If a show is cancelled, competitors may either receive full credit toward a future show, or they may request a refund less a \$10 administrative fee.
- Attire: informal, but neat. All riders must wear helmets and boots with heels. Protective vest for XC is recommended, but not required.
- The USDF Dressage Tests, Training Level and above, will be the new 2007 tests. All USEF Eventing Tests are the 2006 tests. For now, the Intro A & Intro B tests remain the 2003 versions.
- All dogs must be leashed. Small children must be tended to at all times.
- Times will be posted at www.ashlandfarm.com on the Thursday prior to each event. (If all entries are complete & on time, times will be posted earlier.)
- All ride times are tentative. Organizers reserve the right to change ride times.
- Ribbons awarded 1st thru 6th place.
- Results will be posted on our Web site following each event.
- All events will be held in our new Ashland Farm Equestrian Schooling Show Facility. Use the Highway 138 entrance (map on our Web site—do not use MapQuest).
- We have a limited amount of temporary stabling. Call early if you are interested in stabling your horse before or after an event.
